Donor Advised Funds—DAFs

Have you heard about **Donor Advised Funds**, also known as **DAFs**? Many donors are setting up **DAFs**, allowing them to make charitable gifts to nonprofit organizations. A **DAF** is essentially your “giving account” established with a public charity, allowing you to receive an immediate tax deduction and to recommend grants (charitable donations) from the fund.

How does it work?

1) First, you open an account with a financial institution that has a **DAF program** (such as Fidelity or Charles Schwab). You may contribute cash, investments or appreciated assets. **2) Second**, invest your assets with the help of your investment provider. **3) Third**, recommend grants to a recognized 501(c)3 charitable organization, such as **Clelian Heights School**

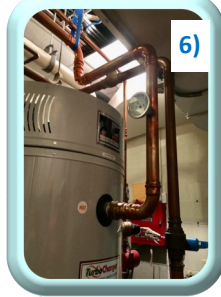
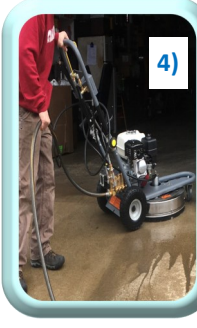
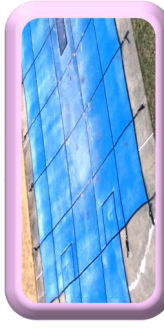
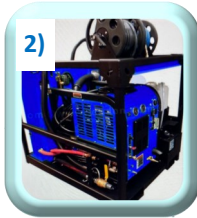

- 6) For Clelian Center commercial laundry and Chip's House: commercial water heater replacement and dining room vinyl tile floor replacement.

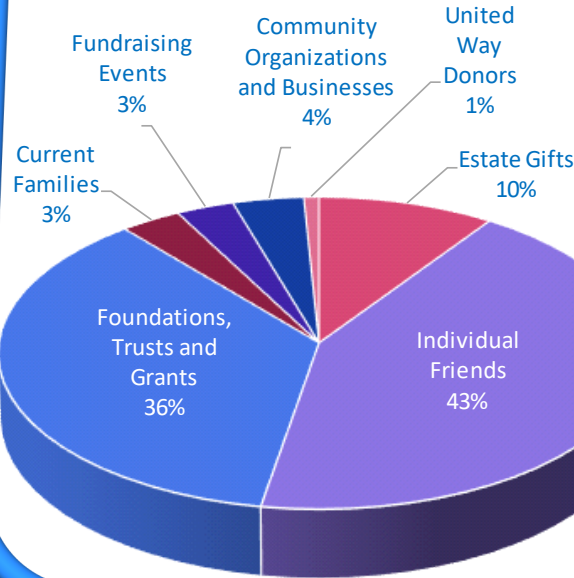
