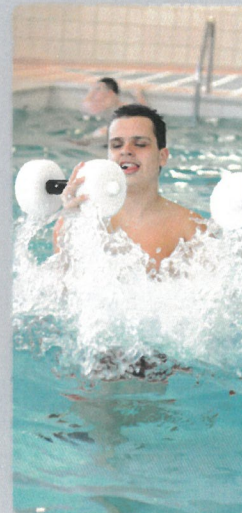

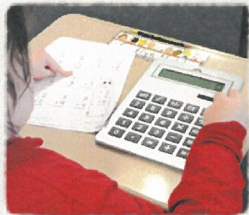
Clelian Heights School responds to the whole student - mind, body, and spirit - in a caring and compassionate environment.

- Individual and small group instruction with a staff to student ratio of 1:2 to bring about intended changes.
- Social, vocational and life skills training maximizes students' potential for independence.
