

Clelian Heights Programs and Campus

The Main Facility in the center of the campus is a large circular building. It connects the Administrative Offices, Clelian Heights School, Chapel, Library, Dining Room, Kitchen, Children's Residences, Clelian Center, and the Therapeutic Recreation Center - Gym, Pool, Fitness Room.

Individualized instruction provides a balanced program of academic, social, and vocational experiences. The **School Curriculum** includes: Reading, Computer, Science/Health, Mobility, Shopping Smart, Math, Speech Therapy, Perceptual and Language Development, Home Management, Physical Education, Religion, Social Studies, Penmanship, Music, Art, Home Economics, Industrial Arts, Personal Care Skills-Health / Safety/Grooming, Listening Skills, Positive Life/Social Skills, Career Awareness, Practical Life Skills, Job Readiness Skills.

The Clelian Center, the Adult Vocational facility, includes the Small Parts Assembly and Mailing Room Operations, Food Service, Commercial Laundry Operations and Ceramics facility. Two additional components of the program are: the Clelian Center Business Services, work contracted from local businesses, and the Clelian Center Employment Services, job coaching and community supported competitive employment.

Chip's House is the men's group home residence. There are the **Sweeney and Melenyzer efficiency Apartments** for those prepared for independent living.
