Clelian Heights Inc., also known as Clelian Heights

School for Exceptional Children, is a licensed, private, non-profit, educational, and vocational facility for children and adults.

Founded in 1961 by the religious community of Sisters, the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Clelian Heights is dedicated to enabling children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, including those on the autism spectrum, to function in the world at their own ability level as contributing and valuable members of society.

Serving Southwestern

Pennsylvania with clients

currently in 7 counties and 20

school districts, Clelian Heights

provides a continuum of care

from age 5 through adulthood

and beyond for 70 students

and 86 adults. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Departments of Human Services and Education

license Clelian Heights programs. Services are

offered to all, without discrimination on the basis of

race, religion, sex, or national origin.



Care begins with a special needs academics environment in the School program beginning at age 5 through 21 that incorporates a transition-to-work program in adolescence and moves on to supported community employment or sheltered employment in adulthood at the Clelian Center where services such as mail operations, packaging, small parts assembly, and commercial laundry are contracted with local businesses. The Clelian Center also produces *Captain and Sandy Gourmet Dog Treats*, and a variety of *Scentsational Soaps* made to order.

The facilities include large

well-equipped classrooms

including a sensory room,

occupational and physical

therapy and speech pathology

rooms, home economics

room, art, music and job

development rooms, dining

and meeting rooms, fitness area,

library, an attached recreation

center with a gym and therapy

pool, an outdoor pool and a large

playground with pavilion, ball field,

amphitheater, picnic area and

bike circle, vocational workshop,

bussing and food service training area, dog biscuit

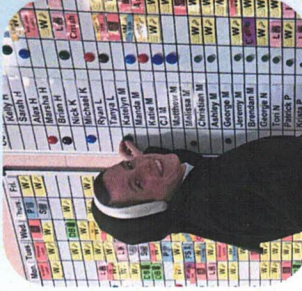


bakery, green house, and a chapel. Also on campus are two apartment buildings for women.

Clelian Heights is the only facility in the area that offers an academic program, adult vocational and personal skills programs, extended school year program, and a residential option for women on its campus.

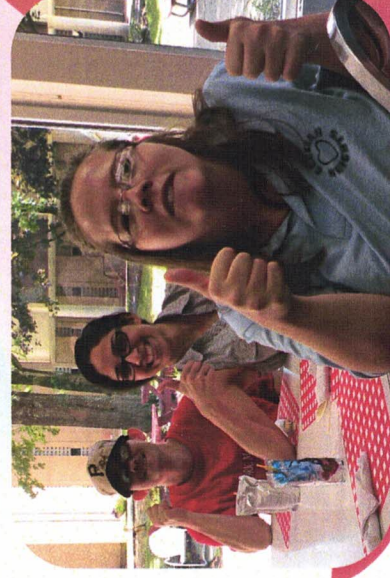
There are over 135

dedicated teachers, aides,

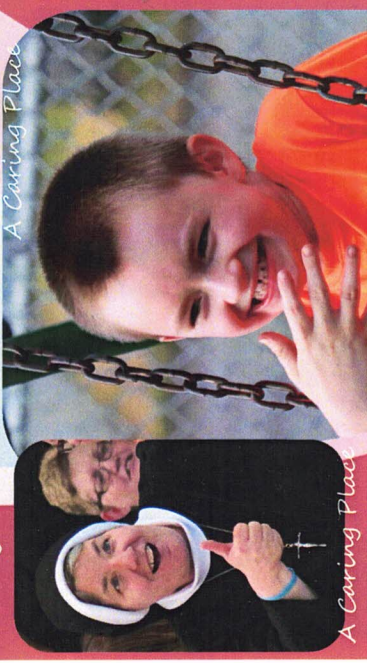


therapists, workshop job coaches and supervisors, resident staff, nursing, administrative, and support staff, along with numerous volunteers who share their time and talents at Clelian.

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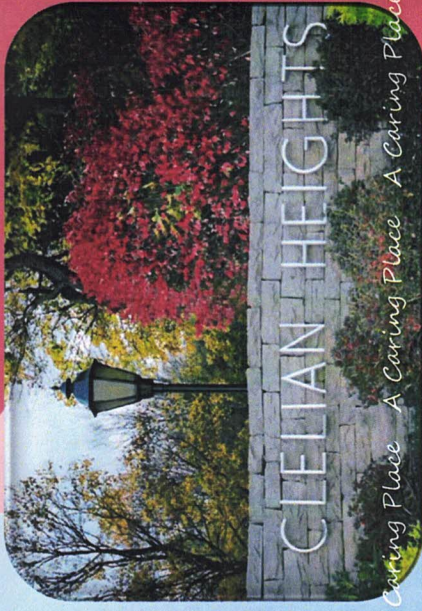


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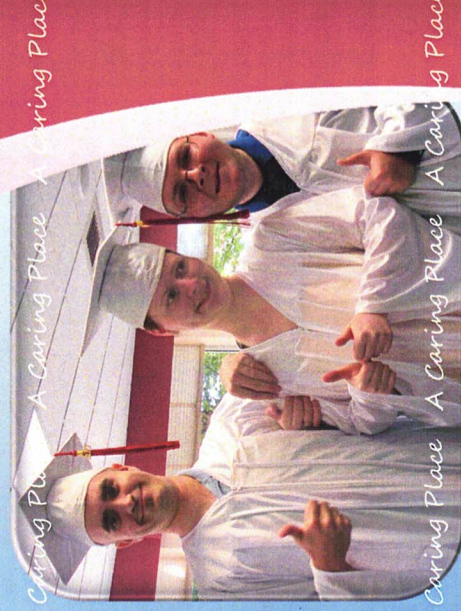

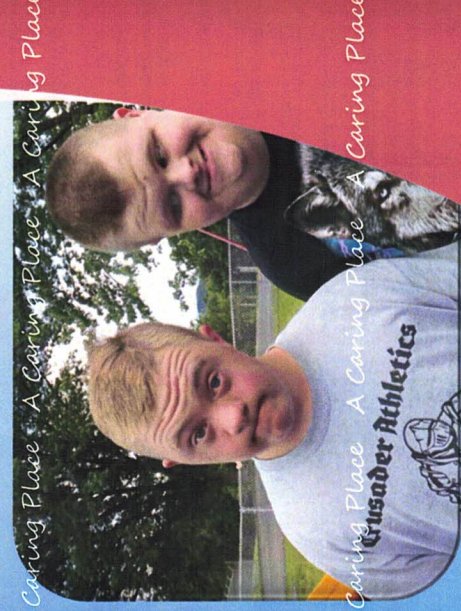
