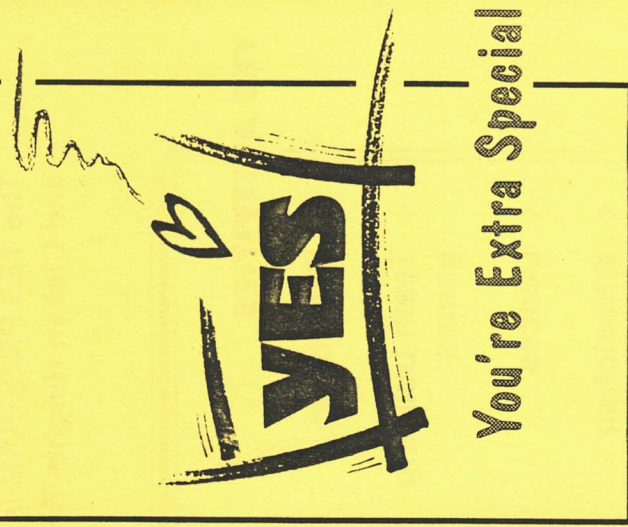


The continued success of the YES program involves support from teachers, administrators, students, support personnel, parents, and the community!!
