



## Clelian Heights at a Glance



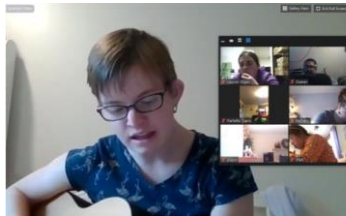

### What's Happening in the Clelian Center?

To allow for enhanced safety measures, the Clelian Center and ATF operated with one-third of the participants in person and another third participating in remote Zoom services until the week before Thanksgiving when heightened COVID-19 numbers in the county demanded a second closure of the programs. To continue the program, the Center made a seamless transition back to remote-only services, and began planning how to creatively incorporate some of the usual subjects and activities into their remote, socially distanced world.





Currently, the Center operates a daily 8:30 - 4:00 Zoom schedule for their adults. A variety of activities are offered by the staff, some of the many activities offered include:

- “Spanish through Song and Games”
- “Sign Language”
- “This N That Chat” to work on conversation skills and group story writing.
- “Music and Movement”
- “Science”
- “Bingo”
- “Show and Tell,”
- “Game Time”
- “Basic Skills”
- “Chapter Book” a chapter or 2 of a chosen chapter book such as, “Where the Red Fern Grows,” and “Charlotte’s Web” is read each session
- “Picture Book Story Time”
- “Art with Ms. Gabby”
- “Anxiety Busters”
- “Scattergories”
- “Drumming”
- “Let’s Make a Deal”
- “Let’s Get Moving”

- “Lunch Bunch” with a variety of staff to practice conversation skills
- “Jeopardy”
- ... activities are being added, changed, and created weekly for our clients!

While all of these activity sessions are happening each day, other dedicated staff members are still taking care of our laundry contracts, mailings and faithfully delivering Meals on Wheels to home bound people who rely on our support to get food several days each week.

The Clelian Center has provided activities sessions this year that not only meet the COVID-19 safety guidelines, but also to engage the Center adults in a variety of experiences each day.
