Our School Garden

The seedlings our students began to grow before learning went virtual last school year, were planted by Ms. Maureen at her home garden. The vegetables gathered from these plants and those from the at-school garden went to two places. Four hundred pounds of produce went to the Westmoreland Food Bank, and other items were used at school for lunches and other snacks.

Along with our usual vegetables and herbs, black beauty tomatoes, purple carrots, and blueberry tomatoes were planted to create a purple plant theme. Our classrooms were able to pick ripe vegetables, prepare Basil and Dill to be used for cooking, and pull seeds from sunflowers for use in the future.
