Have you thought about using a Donor Advised Fund for your charitable giving?

A **Donor Advised Fund (or DAF)** is like a charitable investment account for the purpose of supporting the charitable organizations you care about. When you contribute cash, securities, or other assets to a donor-advised fund, you are eligible to take an immediate tax deduction. Then those funds can be invested for tax-free growth and you can recommend grants to any IRS-qualified public charity, such as Clelian Heights. Establishing a DAF account can be arranged at most major brokerage firms, as well as through community foundations. The initial account needed to open a DAF account and the required future minimum additions and charitable gifts vary. DAFs are a tool that can be right for anyone wishing to max their charitable giving, to be smart and to streamline the administration of gifts. There's no one ideal way to utilize them-they're flexible enough to custom fit a donor's overall giving strategy.
